• What is the CAMPUS Asia Alumni Workshop?

The CAMPUS Asia Alumni Workshop (CAAW) designed to encompass a diverse range of activities aimed at fostering interaction, learning, and experiential opportunities centered on the CAMPUS Asia Program. The CAAW will adopt an offline format, bringing together participants from China, Japan, and the ROK to Jeju Island, ROK. Under the overarching theme of "Synergy for Change: Enhancing the CAMPUS Asia Initiatives for a Better World," the CAAW seeks to explore novel avenues for enhancing both the CAMPUS Asia program and its associated Alumni Network. Concurrently with the Alumni Network gathering, the Jeju Forum will feature expert discussions addressing the current status of the CAMPUS Asia initiative, opportunities for its enhancement, and potential lessons to be learned from the past experiences.

- Program duration: May 28 - May 30, 2024

- Venue: Jeju Island, ROK



• How is the CAAW Organized?

CAAW 2024 will be composed of four main phases: Participate Jeju Forum, CAMPUS Asia Alumni Workshop, Site Visit and Network.

- Jeju Forum: The Jeju Forum for Peace and Prosperity started in 2001. The Forum is an international comprehensive forum in East Asia in which the official aims are to build common peace and prosperity and addressing stability and security issues within the region through international cooperation. The CAAW participants will join one session of the Jeju Forum which will discuss the CAMPUS Asia Program.
- CAMPUS Asia Alumni Workshop: The Workshop is designed to leverage the collective expertise and experiences of past program participants to further promote trilateral cooperation and understanding. During this workshop, alumni will have the opportunity to share insights gained from their participation in the CAMPUS Asia Program and discuss the impact of trilateral collaboration in their respective fields.
- Site Visit: The Site Visits to International Organization in Jeju, Exhibition, and Natural Scenery
- Free Network: This phase aims to foster lasting connections among CAAW 2024 participants, facilitating ongoing collaboration and exchange beyond the workshop.

• What are the benefits of CAAW?

- To enhance understanding of the trilateral cooperation among China, Japan, and the ROK
- To collaboratively explore strategies for improving the CAMPUS Asia Program
- To foster connections between consortia and establish a comprehensive multi-consortium network
- To facilitate communication between current CAMPUS Asia students and alumni, fostering a sense of community and shared experience



• Am I Eligible?

The TCS is recruiting 30 CAMPUS Asia Alumni and current students from China, Japan, and the ROK. Applicants should meet the minimum requirement as follows:

- Age: 35 years old or younger.
- Education: Applicants should have graduated from or currently be enrolled in the CAMPUS Asia Program.
- Nationality: Applicants must hold citizenship of People's Republic of China, Japan, and Republic of Korea.
- Residence: Applicants must currently reside in People's Republic of China, Japan, and Republic of Korea.
- Language Proficiency: Proficiency in English is mandatory. Proficiency in at least one additional language among Chinese, Japanese, or Korean is preferred but not mandatory.
- Interest: Applicants must demonstrate a keen interest in Northeast Asian affairs and a willingness to work in multilateral environments.
- Duration: All participants MUST be present for the whole duration of the program. Early leave will not be accepted.

*We welcome applications from diverse backgrounds, including alumni or current students of different consortiums, to build a vibrant and cross-consortium community.

• Administrative Arrangements

TCS will cover the following expenses for participants:

- Accommodations: 2 persons/room, breakfast included
- International/ domestic Airfare (inbound and outbound)
- Travelers' insurance during the program duration
- Local transportation expenses for official schedules
- 28th Dinner, 29th Lunch, 30th Lunch
- All official expenses for the cultural tour in Jeju
- Activity fee for official schedules

Participants should cover the following expenses:

- Visa fee (if applicable)
- airport limousine/Taxi fee
- 29th Dinner (free time for networking)
- Other personal/private expenses



*If the number of applicants exceeds capacity, TCS will review the submissions and shortlist candidates through document screening.

*If the airfare exceeds the maximum budget, participants may need to cover the remaining cost partially.

Please ensure all required documents and information are provided accurately and completely before the application deadline.
